All entries will be judged and rated on photographic merit. The best image will be selected by persons nominated by the Yorke Peninsula Council. The judges' decision is final and cannot be contested.

The working party will be judging the photos on the following criteria:-

- Creativity;
- Composition;
- Vibrancy; and
- Demonstration of Yorke Peninsula Council Holiday Parks in a positive manner.
